

About the Estate

As the exclusive UK importer, we are delighted to bring you the new 2022 vintage from Beaux Frères. Founded 36 years ago by the Etzel family and wine critic Robert Parker Jr, this renowned Oregon estate has become one of the most talked about producers of Pinot Noir in the New World.

Having tasted vintages back to 2010, we can confidently say that Beaux Frères crafts some world-class Pinot Noir. It rivals the great appellations of Burgundy and deserves to be represented in your cellar. We are not alone in our praise for this cult Oregon estate. As Eric Guido of Vinous explains: "Beaux Frères comfortably remains one of the icons of the region".

"The result is a set of wines that come across as wickedly fresh, complex and solidly fruited," Guido writes of these new releases. Recent vintages are the most well-received and highly-scored to date, whilst older vintages have become increasingly hard to find.



2022 Vintage

After bud break in late March, an unexpected frost hit the Willamette Valley on April 12, damaging over half of our primary buds. This was followed by an unusually cold spring and persistent heavy rains that lasted until June 20.

As a result, our primary fruit-bearing canopy was reduced by approximately 70%. However, a rapid transition to above-average summer temperatures and minimal rainfall by mid-June helped us catch up, leaving us about four weeks behind the 2021 season in development. Flowering began on June 28, yielding one of the most prolific bloom cycles the region has seen in years. While cluster counts were lower than in a frost-free year, larger cluster sizes compensated, leading to yields only about 10% below average.

Harvest took place from October 1 to October 15, with just 0.4 inches (10 mm) of rain during this key period. This favorable weather contributed significantly to the exceptional quality of the vintage.

It has a concentrated core of spice- and earth-laced fruit and a long, nuanced finish. It's dangerously easy to drink without sacrificing nuance."

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The Beaux Frères Vineyard Pinot Noir 2022

"Darkly floral, the 2022 Pinot Noir The Beaux Frères
Vineyard wafts up with an earthy bouquet as flowery
underbrush and crushed ashen stones complicate dried
black cherries and a flourish of lavender. This is cooltoned and racy, with a cascade of sweet spice and ripe
red and blue fruits that flow across a stream of vibrant
acidity. The 2022 finishes structured, long and
beautifully balanced, leaving a classically dry sensation
as rosy inner florals gradually recede. In 2022, Mikey
Metzel pushed the new oak up to 35% from 25% due to
the quality of the tannins and freshness of the fruit."
