Tasting notes

An incredibly refined and linear nose of intense purity and elegance, crisp fruit and a smoky minerality which is all a top Cailleret should be. The palate is a masterclass in balance. Lots of mouthwatering green fruit and Crunchy apples are interwoven with a delicate vein of roasted hazelnuts, all wrapped up with a chalky minerality. This is a wonderful wine defined by its crispness, elegance and texture. Drink from 2015.

A beautifully and highly expressive nose of acacia blossom, cool pear and mineral reduction scents precede exceptionally well-delineated, intense and energetic flavors that possess an abundance of minerality on the impeccably balanced finish.
