Lively aromas of treacle, licorice and rose petals. Dense fruit flavours of cherries and red berry fruits with hints of treacle, chocolate and licorice. Layered, complex and rich with a firm structure and grainy tannins on the finish. Fantastic ageing potential.

About the producer

When Claudio Fenocchio succeeded his father Giacomo at the helm of the family business in 1989, the debate between modernist and traditionalists in Barolo was at its most acute. He decided to opt for a third approach, something many refer to as radical traditionalism. His wines are celebrated for being impressively approachable in youth while getting even better with age. Claudio represents the 5th generation of the Fenocchio family crafting elegant, true Barolos that capture the soul of his vineyards. Far from resting on his laurels though, he continues to push boundaries of quality and innovation while respecting his family legacy.
