Tasting notes

This is a classic Vougeot displaying great depth showing dark berries with notes of undergrowth. It is rich, but well-balanced with great freshness. The wine is showing well now, blossoming out with time in the glass, but will benefit from some more time in the cellar.

Reviews

Good medium red. Rather brooding aromas of dark fruits, licorice and fresh herbs. Then spicy, medicinal and backward in the mouth, with good sweetness and moderate breadth for Clos Vougeot. Finishes with considerable tannins that reach the incisors. Fairly powerful in the context of this group and in need of a solid eight years of cellaring, but is there enough mid-palate stuffing to buffer the tannins?
