Roagna's 2009 Barbaresco Asili Vecchie Viti is another striking wine. Silky, sweet and textured in the glass, the Asili is all about sensuality and pure pleasure. Here, too, Luca Roagna has done a terrific job striking a balance between acidity and ripeness. The Roagna story started in the late 1800s when Luca Roagna's great grandfathers were part of a small group of pioneers that started making Barbaresco as we know it today. Luca, currently representing the 5th generation of winemakers, is taking the estate from strength to strength. He works with the utmost respect for his land: old vines, massale selection, and promotion of biodiversity are all at the core of his approach in the vineyards. In the winery, long aging, wild yeast, and long macerations assure that the essence of his terroir is expressed in the bottle.
