Tasting notes

The Matetic Syrah 2009 is a dark triumphant Syrah that combines the strengths of two different areas within the "Rosario Valley". A perfumed bouquet of violets and orange blossom blends with aromatic spicy notes of cinnamon and crushed black pepper. The palate is full bodied and equally complex with vibrant red fruit notes of raspberry jam compounded by subtle hints of blueberry muffin and melted dark chocolate. This is balanced by fresh acidity and rounded off with notes of nutmeg, leather and peppermint on the finish. The structure suggests this wine will continue to develop and perform well for at least another decade. A true expression of Chilean Syrah. Drink now to 2023.
