Tasting notes

We are big fans of Jean-Marc's Puligny, he has a third of a hectare of 50 year-old vines in the lieu-dit Rue Aux Vaches, just below 1er Cru Pucelles and the combination of the excellent site and the old vines gives a wine of heightened minerality, verve and precision. Classic, floral notes on the nose with vigour and freshness at every turn.

About the producer

Domaine Blain-Gagnard, located in the village of Chassagne-Montrachet, was formed in 1980 when Jean-Marc Blain married Claudine Gagnard. The 9-hectare domaine, comprising two-thirds white and one-third red, boasts vineyards in some of the Côte de Beaune's most prestigious appellations. Jean-Marc, alongside his son Marc-Antoine, oversee a meticulous cellar where judicious use of new oak produces wines of remarkable purity and elegance. These wines are not only approachable in their youth but also possess exceptional aging potential.
