## Tasting notes

---

Deep and concentrated, but incredibly elegant and restrained at the same time. On the nose exotic and elegant cedar notes combine with dark plum, fig and blackberry fruit characters. The palate is very serious and structured with wonderfully refined tannins which balance intense blackberry and cassis flavours. The alcohol is barely perceptible and there is a mouth-wateringly fresh acidity and refined mineral character on the finish which gives definition. This is a very serious wine indeed. Drink 2025 - 2040.

## About the producer

---

Haut Brion and its sister property, La Mission Haut Brion, which was acquired by the Dillon family in 1983 and is situated opposite the main estate, are almost entirely surrounded by the suburbs of Bordeaux. The vineyards are only 5km southwest of the centre of the city and it is a credit to the property that it has managed to continue unaffected by the encroaching urban sprawl.
