The amphitheatre-like Pajé is found on the outskirts of Barbaresco village and is Roagna's flagship holding, hence the three separate cuvées (and a Reserva, too). It's hard to believe that this wine is the most modest of these, with its refined scents of walnuts, saucisson and other fermented meats, its melting wealth of tannin, its tender softness allied to concentration and poise.

The Roagna story started in the late 1800s when Luca Roagna's great-grandfathers were part of a small group of pioneers that started making Barbaresco as we know it today. Luca, currently representing the 5th generation of winemakers, is taking the estate from strength to strength. He works with the utmost respect for his land: old vines, massale selection, and the promotion of biodiversity are all at the core of his approach in the vineyards. In the winery, long ageing, wild yeast, and long macerations ensure that the essence of his terroir is expressed in the bottle.
