Tasting notes

Expressive and direct, showing sweet floral notes, Williams pears and a suggestion of quince. On the palate, there is a relaxed composed feel with sufficient acidity to ensure a fresh finish. A further winter in stainless steel will tighten it up but even so, this will be hard to resist upon release.

About the producer

The vision of Anne-Claude Leflaive in the 1990s took this Puligny Montrachet Domaine to the heights of white wine production, not only in Burgundy but in the rest of the world. Today, her nephew Brice de La Morandière - who has had a successful career running multinational companies - continues her philosophy of organic, biodynamic viticulture, bringing Chardonnay grapes to their best possible expression in Grand Cru and Premier Cru climates, where the terroir has been restored to health by natural practices.
