Tasting notes

Ethereal in character, this is a delicious Corton which has powerful, floral aromas with pure, dark fruits in the background. Smooth tannins blend seamlessly with attractive redcurrant and blackberry fruit flavours with perfumed notes above and a hint of exotic spice on the finish. This is fluid and energetic but beneath the seductive charm lies serious depth and power. Drink from 2016.

One of the truly great, historic Domaine of Burgundy, with stunning cellars and many glorious holdings from Gevrey to Pommard, via some brilliant Grands Crus, Erwan and his new team have everything that a Burgundian could desire. Traditionally, the Faiveley style was uncompromising but while still unquestionably making some of the longest-lived wines in the Côte, there is today far more finesse and precision in evidence, pointing to a more careful and up-to-date approach
