### Tasting notes

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The EQ Pinot Noir is ruby coloured with an aromatic nose dominated by perfumed violets and fresh red fruit. The medium bodied palate gives clear notes of strawberry and raspberry compote intermingling with black cherries and balanced by a refreshing minerality that comes from the granitic soil in the Valle Hermoso vineyard. The complexity of the fruit is complemented with spicy essence of cloves, Christmas spice and cigar box flavours that linger on the finish. Beautifully complex for such a young Pinot, this is drinking superbly now and will develop even more sophistication with age. Drink now to 2024.
