### Tasting notes

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An aromatic wine with a lovely floral bouquet combined with bright redcurrant fruit aromas. Darker, savoury notes open up in the glass. The palate is very expressive with lively redcurrant fruit flavours and a violet, floral character balanced by fine tannins and an energetic freshness which runs through to the finish. This vineyard is located halfway up a steep slope with a full southern exposure which gives the wines great personality. It will be delicious in a few years and has good ageing potential. Drink from 2014.

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Established in 1868, Domaine Simon Bize became a reference in Savigny-lès-Beaune under the stewardship of Patrick Bize. His meticulous care and attention to detail birthed crystalline wines of impressive elegance and poise.
