Once again, this is the go-to wine if you wish to find something to match the textbook definition of Volnay: lacy, feminine and elegant. This wine is endlessly pretty, offering perfume alongside its fruit, a gentle caress on the finish and a lingering, graceful finish. Pinot and Volnay at their most attractive. Drink from 2014.

(from vines planted on deeper soil in the mid-1950s): Bright medium red. An explosion of red fruits, flowers and spices on the tangy nose. Sweet, supple and fruit-driven, offering moderate depth and an attractive balance of sweetness and acidity. Finishes with firm tannins. Score: 88/100 Tanzer
