Tasting notes

This is in a fruit-forward, lifted and fragranced style, a mile away from some of the more ponderous offerings in the Clos. It serves to remind you that you are, after all, on the edge of Chambolle Musigny! With hearts won over, the mind is also tested as the multi-layered palate suggests plenty of material to unfurl in the years ahead too. The tannins are handled with real dexterity and the combination of this, the beautiful fruit and the calm, elegant presentation suggests a wine of fabulous quality. Drink from 2019.

About the producer

One of the great estates in Burgundy, Domaine de Montille produces incredibly elegant and understated wines. Established by Hubert de Montille, who inherited a few Volnay vines in 1951, the estate now comprises 17 ha. The wines had a reputation for requiring a long time to reach maturity but under Étienne de Montille, with the help of Chef de Cave Brian Sieve, the aromatic complexity of the wines has been brought to the fore.
