## Tasting notes

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In total contrast to the Cailleret, this was tight, unyielding and uncompromising in style. Clearly needing more time to develop in the cellar over the winter months. What is undeniably there though, is purity and terrific concentration, almost confronting and brutal. This is a serious wine that will need patience but the material and potential is of the highest order. Drink from 2019.

## About the producer

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Domaine de Montille is one of Burgundy's greatest estates. The wines are made for ageing but in recent years, since Hubert's son Etienne has taken over, the Domaine has moved towards expressing greater aromatic potential in the wines. The Domaine has moved progressively towards organic and now biodynamic methods working in closer harmony with nature. The wines still benefit from ageing and develop an abundance of complexity as they mature.
