Tasting notes

Bright, lemon coloured Sauvignon Blanc with a complex nose of gooseberries, peach, grapefruit and lemon. The palate is dominated by citrus notes of grapefruit and lemon. The cooling sea breeze that passes through the Valle Hermoso vineyard provides slow ripening that enhances this fruit character and also offers some desirable herbal notes that dance on the palate. This wine contains all the forward fruit expected from a Chilean Sauvignon Blanc, it is perfectly balanced with mouth-watering acidity, an herbaceous quality from the coastal breeze and refreshing minerality.
