Tasting notes

Apple, lemon, huge intensity, acidity provides a substantial backbone for the wine and the fruit is very concentrated. The minerality is superb and dominates on a lengthy finish. The energy in this wine is incredible; it is very harmonious.

About the producer

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the south-east of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sébastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closely with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis - mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
