Established in 1984, Rockford is now in its 40th year and prides itself on maintaining the best of the traditional Australian wine trade. Founded by Robert O'Callaghan, the winery is a family-owned Barossa institution using traditional Barossa grape varieties, with some vines dating back to the 1880s.
