Tasting notes

50% Grenache 40% Mataro 10% Shiraz. Grenache supplies tangy sour cherry to this blend whilst Mataro offers a savoury cocoa note and Shiraz holds it all together with a backbone of fine tannins and a touch of brambly fruit. The wine is elegant and restrained with a subtle note of vanilla and pretty floral notes.

About the producer

Established in 1984, Rockford is now in its 40th year and prides itself on maintaining the best of the traditional Australian wine trade. Founded by Robert O'Callaghan, the winery is a family-owned Barossa institution using traditional Barossa grape varieties, with some vines dating back to the 1880s. Much of the winery equipment also dates back well over 100 years. This unique approach to traditional winemaking, results in a range of wines which represent the pinnacle of quality that the Barossa has to offer.
