“Nuances of dusty florals, rosemary, sage, clove and leather give way to dried strawberry aromas as the radiant 2019 Brunello di Montalcino Vigneti del Versante blossoms in the glass. It's silky-smooth and deep, displaying extraordinary elegance. Soothingly soft textures, ripe red and blue fruit notes and a kick of vibrant acidity provide fantastic energy. Sweet, crunchy tannins steadily build toward the violet-tinged finale, tapering off with hints of blood orange and spice. In a word, spellbinding.”

About the producer

Founded in 1997 by Caroline Pobitzer and Jan Erbach, united by their passion for the great wines of Montalcino. Pian dell'Orino is located in the namesake area just a stone's throw away from Tenuta il Greppo, the estate totals 11.5ha, 5.8ha of vineyards, 1.5ha of olive trees and 3.5ha of woods. They specialize solely in Sangiovese grapes cultivated in 7 different subplots with 22 different clones planted in painstaking research of perfection. Total production is around 17,000 bottles per annum making these wines highly sought-after and strictly limited.
