Tasting notes

This no sulfur added Grenache reveals the beauty of the terroir in La Livinière. From old vines shaped like goblets, the wine has a unique personality, talking about fruit, live soil and harmony. A pure, fresh delight, naïve but with strong convictions.

Color is deep red with violet hues. Elegant aromas of red fruits (pomegranate, cherry) and wild Mediterranean herbs. The medium-bodied mouthfeel seduces by its freshness, its roundness, its juicy and vibrant character. Aging potential: 3-5 years.

Food pairing: Cured ham, gratin dauphinois, beetroot and walnut salad.

About the producer

Château Maris is one of the most forward-looking producers in the world, named a “sustainability hero” by Jancis Robinson MW and awarded a ‘Green Emblem’ by the Wine Advocate. It was the first European vineyard to receive the B Corporation certification, an incredibly rigorous sustainability award that is only held by 34 wineries worldwide today. Maris boasts a world-first carbon-negative winery constructed from hemp bricks, while the vineyards are hand-harvested and tilled by a horse-drawn plough. Sales of their wine support local wildlife and biodiversity initiatives such as L’Aspas and La Masion de L’Abeille, and they have even made headlines for shipping wine to the USA by sailboat!
