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*"85% Furmint; the rest is Sárgamuskotály (aka Muscat à Petits Grains), Hárslevelű and Kabar. Real tension. Greengage and essence of lime. A touch of stone dust on the nose. The acidity defines the wine more than flavours, although as the wine sits in the glass, an outline of peach develops. Salinity. Long, bold and confident. Appetising. Cleansing. Drink 2023 - 2026."*
