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76% Zinfandel, 16% Carignan, 6% Petite Sirah and 2% Alicante Bouschet

Winemaker note:

“We have made this Zinfandel every year for fifty-six years. Consistency of quality and vineyard character are its hallmarks. A dry winter with a moderate spring and summer ripened the grapes evenly. Showing plentiful fruit, elegant tannins and bright acidity, this fine wine will develop fully over the next fourteen years.”

Wines are expected to land Autumn 2023.

### About the producer

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Ridge Vineyards is one of the leading lights of Californian viticulture. When Paul Draper retired from Ridge in 2016 there was some concern for the estate’s future, seven years later, under the stewardship of John Olney, Ridge wines are as good as ever. If you want California in a glass look no further than these wonderful Ridge Zinfandels. While conveying sunshine and ripe fruit, these wines do have a serious side to them and are relatively restrained compared to Zinfandels from some other producers. These can be appreciated today, but will develop greater complexity over the next 5-10 years.
