It remains a little closed at this young stage, but that quality gives us even more confidence in a successful bottle evolution. Fruit is sourced from various vineyard plots. There is a hint of greenness that should relax with time, and the wine shows tart cherry fruit, rye bread and a hint of red beer.”

### About the producer

Founded in 1997 by Caroline Pobitzer and Jan Erbach, united by their passion for the great wines of Montalcino. Pian dell'Orino is located in the namesake area just a stone's throw away from Tenuta il Greppo, the estate totals 11.5ha, 5.8ha of vineyards, 1.5ha of olive trees and 3.5ha of woods. They specialize solely in Sangiovese grapes cultivated in 7 different subplots with 22 different clones planted in painstaking research of perfection. Total production is around 17,000 bottles per annum making these wines highly sought-after and strictly limited.
