Tasting notes

This wine is an astonishing blend of 127 wines from 11 different vintages. Sitting at either end of the vintage spectrum here we have 1990 as the oldest wine and a generous proportion of the stunning 2008. This then is a Champagne which has been more than 25 years in the making! The 1990 vintage was one of the finest of the Twentieth Century - bold rich and generous - it adds depth and burnished, golden fruit. Then there is the latest, greatest prodigy of a Champagne vintage, 2008, around which this edition of Grand Cuvée is centred. Most similar to 2002 (also in this blend) the Champagnes of 2008 are pure, focussed and linear. A shimmering, dazzling expression of fruit in seamless focus and harmony destined to become legendary. World renowned Champagne expert Richard Juhlin hails it as an 'an absolutely gorgeous vintage that has it all. I have a hard time imagining anything other than buying everything you see of this vintage'.
